

**MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD  
THURSDAY 23 JANUARY 2014 IN THE CAVENDISH ROOM IN THE SOCIAL CENTRE  
COMMENCING AT 3.00PM.**

**Police Report:**

PCSO Matt Wardle reported on the December crime figures which were very good. There had been no house burglaries over the Christmas period and only 10 incidents overall including 3 for shop-lifting, theft of a mountain bike and various other minor offences. In answer to a question regarding CCTV cameras, PCSO Wardle confirmed that the cameras are working and monitored regularly but not constantly manned. There is also an issue with the quality of cameras at night.

Cllr. D. McGregor requested the report be deferred to the next meeting in order to move on with the agenda.

**207. To Approve the Minutes**

Cllr. D. McGregor proposed, seconded by Cllr. S Smith that the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 28 November 2013 were a true record subject to the following amendments. Item 205 – It was confirmed that Mr Nunn be appointed as Clerk with effect from 1 January 2014.

**209. Planning**

**210. Finance**

**i) Bowls Club Blinds**

Following a request for replacement blinds at the Bowls Club, 2 quotes were presented to the Council for replacement blinds in the Bowls Club. It was agreed not to go ahead at this present time.

**ii) To Book Dreams Pantomime Company for 2015**

It was agreed that the above be booked for next year's pantomime on Sunday 4 January 2015.

**iii) To Re-Order Clerk's Magazine**

The Council agreed that the subscription be renewed for 1 year but to reduce the amount of copies.

**iv) Request for Financial Assistance**

A request for funding had been received from R.A.S.C.A.L.S; a new special needs group forming in Creswell. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Smith that £100 be donated to the group. All present were in agreement.

v) **To Agree Cost of Big Band for WW1 Commemorations.**

Cllr. McGregor proposed, seconded by Cllr. Smith that £500 be approved for the cost of hiring the Big Band Company for a Commemoration evening in September.

**211. Bus Shelter**

Mr Elliott confirmed that a Consultation had taken place with local residents, with one objection being received. It was felt the objection wouldn't warrant the scheme not going ahead and the necessary documentation will be submitted to Derbyshire County Council for final approval. The cost of erecting the bus shelter is approximately £3,300 with the Parish Council contributing 50%. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Gilfillan.
