#### 123. BOLSOVER POLICE REPORT

#### 125. BOLSOVER DISTRICT COUNCIL REPORT

Cllr. McGregor reported on the following:

- Details of public consultation dates and venues for Bolsover District Regeneration Frameworks.
- A decision regarding D2N2 was expected in September.

#### 126. COUNTY COUNCIL REPORT

Cllr. McGregor reported on the following:

- He had asked for litter picks on Craggs Road and Hazelmere Road.
- He also reported that he had asked for monitoring of car parking outside the Primary School and that he had been informed that since 1 April 2015 13 penalty charges had been issued.
- Support Services for Sheltered Housing from D.C.C. were to continue.
- D.C.C. had approved £160,000 for patch repairs to pot holes.
- Action was to be taken about signs attached to walls and fences without the necessary permission.

Cllr Glassey reported that a costing exercise had been undertaken to determine the price of the tickets for the Queens 90th Birthday event. It was unanimously agreed that the tickets be priced at £5 pending confirmation of the band and associated costs.

Cllr Glassey also reported that the proposed menus for weddings be presented to the next Parish Council meeting for approval.

**128. FINANCIAL MATTERS****a) Financial Statement for February 2016.**

The Clerk/RFO presented the financial statement for February 2016 and answered several questions regarding certain variances.

Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Smith that the financial statement be approved.

**Motion Carried****b) Accounts for Payments (March 2016)**

In response to a question regarding an individual payment, The Clerk reported that a tree survey had been undertaken to assess the condition of the trees on the railway embankment on Elmton Road. The survey highlighted that 2 trees damaged by fire should be removed. It was agreed that the owner of the adjacent property be asked to contribute towards the cost of the trees removal.

**129. OPEN SPACES REPORT**

Cllr. Smith reported on the Creswell Swimming Pool Working Group meeting held on 8 March, details minuted at item 131.

Cllr. Smith reported that he had met with Big Local to discuss the refurbishment/repair of the tourist notice boards around the village. It was agreed in principle that the Parish Council would be willing to participate in this project. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Smith.

**130. PLANNING**

There were no issues raised regarding the following planning applications.

15/00368/FUL – Development of 82 dwellings and new access from Skinner Street - granted.

16/00029/FUL – Change of use of agricultural barn to residential dwelling.

16/00082/FUL – Retrospective application - erection of boundary fence - 8B Chatsworth Road, Creswell.

**131. Creswell Swimming Pool**

Cllr. Smith reported on the meeting of the Creswell Swimming Baths Working Group held on 8 March. He informed the Council that a local consultation meeting was to be held at the Social Centre on the 7 April at which Ideas for the future use of the building could be put forward.

**132. CORRESPONDENCE**

**Big Local** - a request had been received from Big Local for free hire of the Social Centre during the School summer holidays for weekly film shows for children. It was agreed that a decision on this be deferred until the budget review of Social Centre charges had been completed. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Glassey.
