

**MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON  
THURSDAY 26 JULY 2018 IN THE CAVENDISH ROOM AT THE SOCIAL CENTRE

**35. Apologies for Absence**

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs. N. Sanders, J Wells, P Colbert and J Clifton.

**36. PCC Hardyal Dhindsa**

The Chairman welcomed PCC Dhindsa to the meeting who gave an overview of his role and also of issues affecting the police service at the present time. He answered several questions from members particularly around police officer numbers and lack of attendance at Parish Council meetings. The Chairman thanked the Commissioner for attending the meeting and for giving his views.

**37. Declarations of Interest**

Declarations of interest were received from Cllr. Turner – Planning Level 1.

**38. Bolsover Police Report**

The new PCSO allocated to Creswell attended the meeting briefly to introduce himself to the Council.

**40. Bolsover District Council Report**

Cllr. McGregor did not have anything specific to report.

**41. County Council Report**

Cllr. McGregor did not have anything specific to report.

**42. To approve the minutes of the following meetings**

**42.1 Parish Council – 28 June 2018**

The minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 28 June were approved as a correct record subject to the inclusion of Cllr. Richardson as an attendee at the meeting. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Gilfillan. **Motion Carried**

**42.2 Audit Committee – 11 July 2018**

The minutes of the Audit Committee held on 11 July were approved as a correct record. Cllr. Smith moved, seconded by Cllr. Glassey. **Action Clerk**

**42.3 Management Committee – 11 July 2018**

The minutes of the Management Committee held on 11 July were approved as a correct record. Cllr. Gilfillan moved, seconded by Cllr. Glassey. **Motion Carried**

It was highlighted that the Management committee had agreed not to take on the role as promoter for Live n' Local events at this present time.

**42.4 Special Meeting held 19 July**

The minutes of a Special meeting held on 19 July were approved as a correct record. Cllr. Glassey moved, seconded by Cllr. Smith. **Motion Carried**

**43. Recommendations from Audit Committee – 11 July 2018**

**43.1 Policy Document Relating to PPE – to approve**

The Clerk explained the need to have a clear policy regarding the wearing of PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) by Parish Council staff.

Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Glassey that the policy presented be approved. **Motion Carried**

**43.2 Sports Club – Request Information on How Youth Participation is Encouraged**

The Audit Committee recommended that sports clubs in Creswell be asked how they were encouraging participation by younger age groups. It was agreed that the Council would write to the sports clubs requesting information and offering its support. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Smith. **Action Clerk**

**44. Financial matters:**

**44.1 Financial Statement for June 2018**

The Clerk presented the report for Period 3 June 2018 pointing out that at this time there were no significant variations to consider. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Glassey that the report be approved. **Motion Carried**

**44.2 Accounts for payments July 2018**

Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Richardson that the accounts for payment be approved. **Motion carried**

**45. Planning:**

18/00366/FUL – Single Storey side extension and detached garden room – Mansfield Road. There were no issues relating to this application.

**46. Correspondence**

**46.1 Brass Band**

The Clerk read out a letter asking if the Parish Council would be willing to contribute towards next years the Bolsover Brass Band festival. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Smith that the request be supported. **Motion Carried/Action Clerk**

**46.2 Creswell Subway**

A letter had been received regarding the shabby condition of the railway underpass in the village. The Council agreed that it was not a Parish Council issue and that contact is made with the County Council and Network rail to establish who has responsibility for its maintenance. **Action Clerk**

**The following items were discussed under correspondence**

**46.3 Main Hall Lighting**

It was agreed due to Health and Safety reasons to go ahead with adjustments to the Social Centre main hall lighting by installing dimmer lights at a cost of £1690. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Gilfillan. **All in favour/Motion Carried**

46.4 **Portland Room**

To consider minor decorations to the Portland room. Quotes for this work has not yet been received. Item deferred until September meeting. **Agenda Item**

46.5 **Social Centre Assistant Manager**

Following a discussion it was agreed the position would be advertised around local villages, the website and social media. **Action Social Centre Manager**

46.6 **Social Centre - Change of Name**

The Social Centre Manager asked the Council to give consideration into changing the name of the Social Centre. He felt a change of name would help promote the building for weddings and other functions. He gave several examples of what he felt the building could be called in order to give it a more up to date identity and hopefully a positive impact on bookings. The Council agreed with the proposal and after a show of hands it was agreed the Centre would be renamed 'Creswell Events Centre'. Cllr. McGregor moved, seconded by Cllr. Glassey. **Motion Carried**

At this point Cllr. McGregor reported that the housing developers at the rear of the Model Village are looking to create a foul water sewer outlet for the new properties adjacent to the multi-sports pavilion. The developers are seeking permission from the Parish Council to investigate the possible use of land within the boundary of the multi-sports area, which should it prove constructive, could lead to this being made subject of an Easement Access Rights. Cllr. McGregor suggested that the Council agree in principle to the request subject to the specifications of the dig and a guarantee that the developers are responsible for any damage to the fence or surrounding area. All in favour.

Cllr. McGregor also reported that the legal formalities for the new proposed Health Centre are now nearing the final stages. Cllr. McGregor moved that the Council write to the Clinical Commissioning Group asking for a specific time and date for the start of the new centre or the Council would arrange a meeting seeking public views on the delay. **Action Clerk**

There being no other business the Chairperson declared the meeting closed at 4.40pm.
